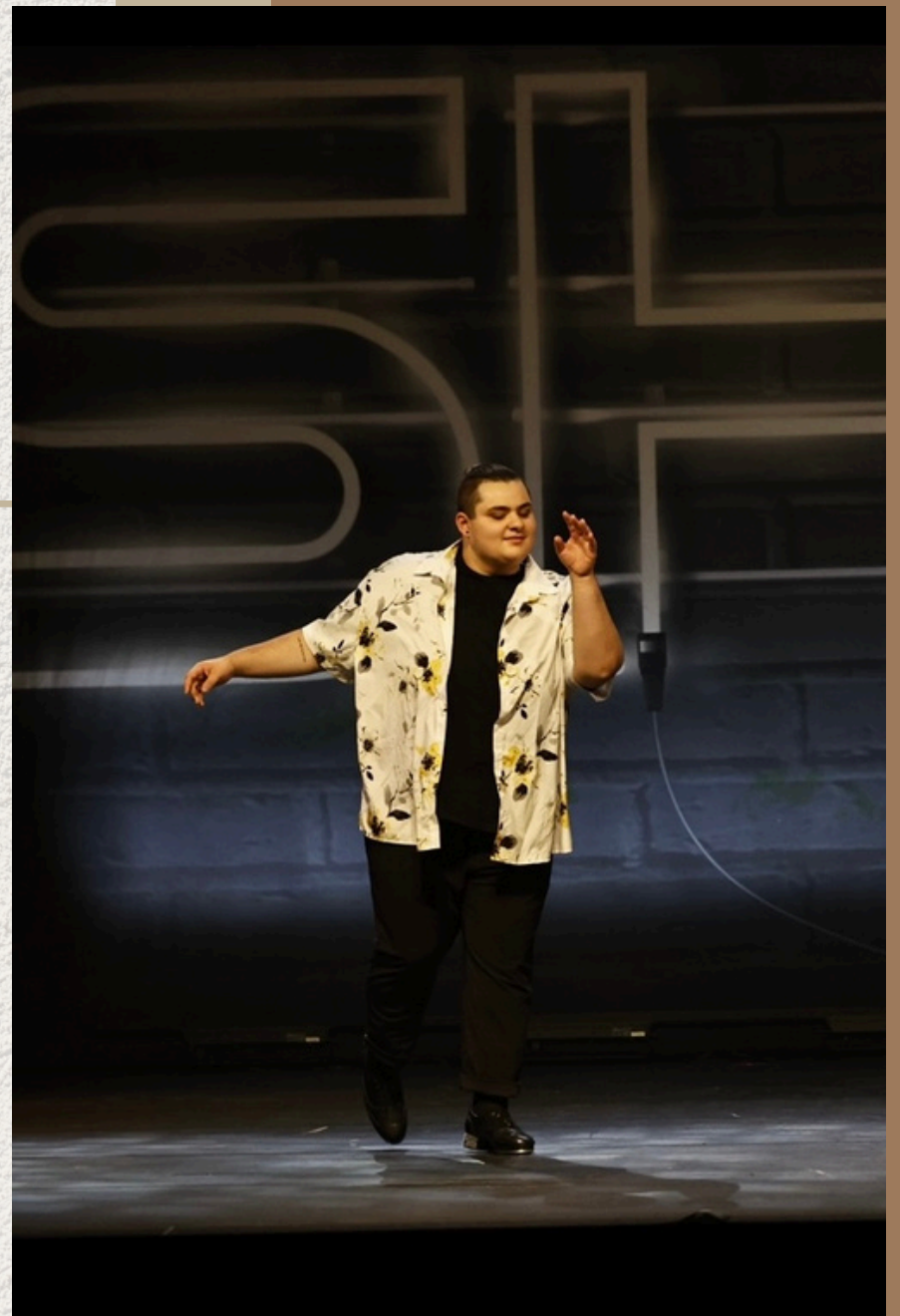


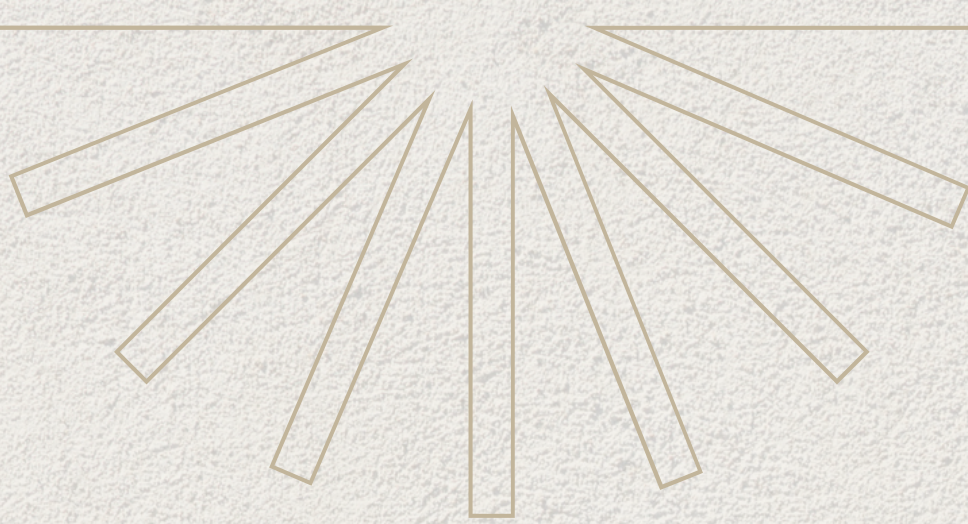
Julian Bellante
